People are Tightening Their Belts at the Stores

We are seeing it all around us from high income to low income families. Everything consumers need is rising in cost across the board from groceries to clothes and everything in-between.

Agape Food Pantry is also seeing these results from January 2022 to August 2022 compared to January 2023 to August 2023. Households served by Agape Food Pantry is up by 294 (37%), people served is up by 723 people (34%), new families is up by 21 (18%) and pantry price of clients served is up \$38,915 (70%).

"Hunger exists in every community across our region," he said. "The hunger looks a lot like you and me, and it lives just down the street." said Mike Hochron, senior vice president of communications of Mid-Ohio Food Collective as published in the Columbus Dispatch.



School is Back in Session

The smell of fall is in the air and that means only one thing...school is back in session. We had a very successful summer here at Agape Ministries, Inc. With the generous donations by our community we purchased 150 school supply kits and were able to help our client's children with back to school supplies during the months of July and August. We did our program differently this year and it went very smoothly for all involved.

Our summer Feeding Program bags were distributed to our clients during their pantry time and we served 179 bags to feed 339 children at a cost of \$2.792.40.



Do You Know a Senior In Need?

Food boxes are packed full of nutritious shelf stable food, toiletries, hygiene and cleaning supplies and delivered to seniors who are homebound the first week of every month. Agape Ministries, Inc works in collaboration with the Auglaize County Council on Aging in getting these boxes delivered to the senior's homes.
