The West Ohio Food Bank, Kroger, Walmart, and Aldi for instance, helps us to provide nutritious food to our clients, while the ACCA assists us in providing support to the elderly in our community. The United Way and St. Marys Community Foundation is instrumental in helping us to raise funds to support our programs to help us meet the needs of our clients.

At Agape Ministries, we work with area agencies to distribute food and other resources to those in need by referrals to and from these agencies, while WOCAP and Job and Family Services offer financial assistance to those who are facing financial difficulties. The Homeless Coalition provides temporary housing for individuals and families who may be facing homelessness, and Job & Family Services offers employment and training programs to help people gain the skills they need to succeed in the workforce.
